This Order is made by the Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

Uttlesford District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the Order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated east of the property Langthorns known as Footpath 29 Little Canfield in the District of Uttlesford and shown by a bold black continuous line on the order map numbered LCAN 29X attached to this order and described in the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

2. Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Order any statutory undertakers shall still have rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 above.

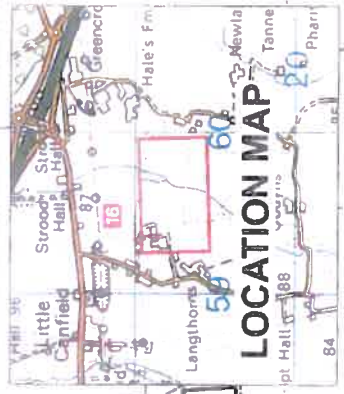
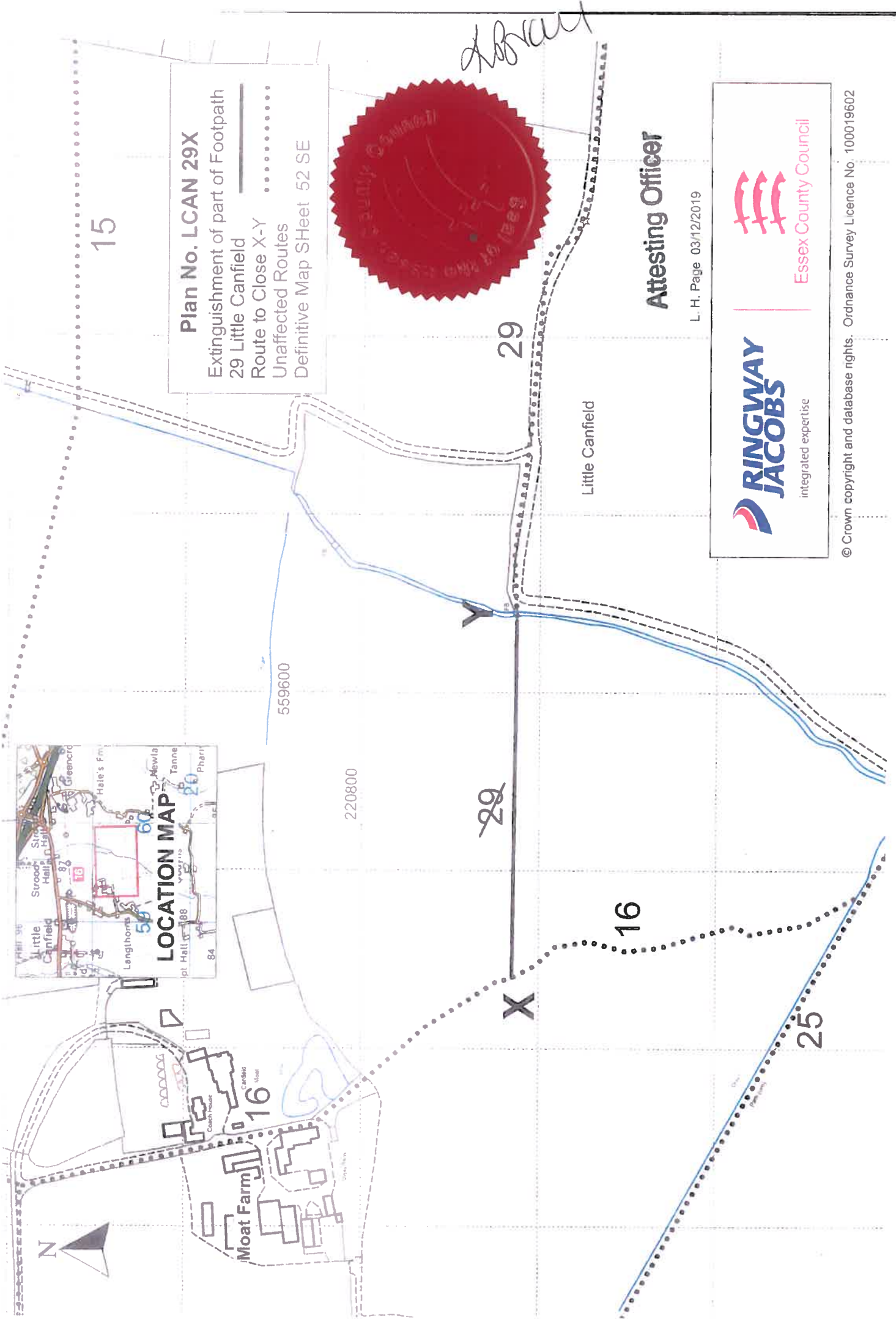
